5 Group Rules and Regulations

1. 5 Group shall consist of 5 dancers. Dancers can be male or female with combinations acceptable. Ex. 3 girls and 2 boys, 5 girls, 5 boys, 1 boy and 4 girls, Ect...
2. Live drumming will receive 5 points extra but Music on an iPod is permitted.
3. 5 Group must compete in all 3 categories:
 - Opening Otea
 - Soloist or Couples Dance
 - Aparima
4. Each competing team can only enter 5 Group category once and will be disqualified if any dancer participating competed with another group already entered in this category.
5. Judging criteria will be based on entrance and exit, Otea, theme, skill, and costume.
6. A minimum of 5 minutes and Maximum of 15 minutes is permitted. For every minute outside of that time bracket 5 points will be deducted.
7. All dancers must be available at least 30 minutes before their performance time.
8. No Age limit and theme can be of your choice.

HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

August 11 - 12, 2018

This hold harmless agreement is made between the Parties of each participating organization, vendor, and performer (hereinafter, Participant) and Reva Tahiti Productions (hereinafter, RTP) and Heiva San Diego -it's Committees, Board, Officers, and Heiva San Diego Volunteers, (hereinafter,HSD).

TERMS

1) Hold Harmless: Upon Participant’s taking part at HSD by their employees, agents, invites, volunteers, and students for the purpose of their involvement with HSD, Participant shall hold harmless and indemnify RTP and HSD, from every liability, claim or demand, made by reason of:

a. Any injury to person or property, sustained by any person, firm or corporation caused by any act (willful or not), neglect, default, or omission of the participant or any person, firm,or corporation directly or indirectly engaged by it upon or in connection with HSD, whether the

injury or damage occurs at the HSD venue, a host hotel, or any other event related location.

b. For the use of any copyrighted or un-copyrighted composition, Tahitian cultural sacred protocol, patented or un-patented invention, article, or appliance during HSD.

c. For the use of their image (s) or likeness for advertising purposes and allows HSD to videotape and photograph their performance or presence at HSD for their archives and use within HSD videotape, website and all other related media.

2) Authority to Enter Agreement: Each Participant warrants that the individual who signs this document has the legal power, right, and authority to make this Agreement and bind each respective Participant.

3) Amendment: Modifications: No supplement, modification, or amendment of this Agreement shall be binding unless executed in writing and signed by both Parties.

4) Attorneys’ Fees and Costs: In the case of legal action or other proceedings due to breach of this agreement, the successful or prevailing Party shall be entitled to recover reasonable attorneys’ fees and other related costs.
